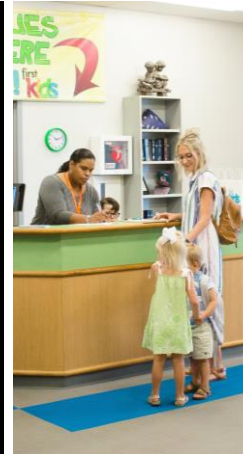


Having a historical video record of events is critical for areas with very small children.
